Harold presented report from Industrial Safety Consultant, Harry Harper who conducted a safety survey at Pike Township Building on November 7, 1994, the recommendations were listed: Vent tanks vertically and twelve feet high; Post No Smoking signs; Supply leg protection for chain saw work and enforce its use; Keep work rests in place whenever feasible for the work being performed, and keep them adjusted closely to the wheel with a maximum opening of one-eighth inch to prevent the work from jammed between the wheel and the rest, which could cause wheel breakage. Adjust the work rests only when the wheel is stationary, and securely clamp the work rest after each adjustment; AdJust tongue guard to within one-fourth inch of the constantly decreasing diameter of the wheel. Readjust as necessary; Use only electrical equipment that has adequate insulation (refrigerator in kitchen) Damaged or inadequate insulation should be repalced by a qualified electrician; Replace the power cord on the refrigerator. Use a three-wire cord having a three-prong cap with an approved grounding conductor; Remove the appliance from service until a qualified person can replace or repair the power cord on the fan, using a three-wire cord and a three-prong cap with an approved grounding conductor; Replace the lamp fixture with one that includes a lamp guard, or purchase and install a guard from an electrical supply house or lighting vendor, or fashion and install a guard from expanded metal or mesh; Replace the spliced cord with a continuous cord of the proper size and type for your use. Note that hard service cords with number 12 or greater size conductors may be repaired or spliced providing that the splice retains the insulation, outer sheath, and usage characteristics of the cord being spliced. The use of electrical tape does not generally meet this requirement; Replace non-explosion proof lights with explosion proof lights; Install a sign marked "Exit" over the doorway so that employees in the area can see the way to the exit readily in an emergency; Verify the workplace hazard assessment through a written certification that identifies the work areas evaluated, persons performing evaluation, and date of assessment; Training of all employees; Develop & implement a written hazard communication programEmployers are required to have on hand an MSDS for every hazardous chemical used or manufactured, including intermediate substances to which employees might be exposed and substances not commonly recognized as manufactured chemicals, such as carbon monoxide from lift trucks, used oil, welding fumes and wood dust; Develop & Implement a procedure to insure employees are trained on hazardous chemicals upon initial assignment & whenever a new hazard is introduced into the workplace. Rod will report later as to items that have been corrected.
