The Pike Township Trustees met in a regular session April 16, 2024 for the purpose of conducting the business at hand.

The Meeting was called to order at 8:30 a.m. by the President Adam Steele, with Vice President James Davidson and Greg Kaffenbarger answering the roll call. Also in attendance was Jerry Donnelly, Bob Miller and Cheryl Sigler.

All attendees stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.

## R# 37 / 2024 APPROVE APRIL 2 2024 MINUTES

Motion by Mr. Davidson seconded by Mr. Kaffenbarger approve the April 2, 2024 meeting minutes. Motion passed.

Bob received a call from the resident at 10900 Sigler Road, his culvert pipe had a blow out and he would like to purchase a pipe from the township, Bob advised him that the township could replace the culvert and the resident would only be responsible for the cost of the pipe. He will call and get a price.

8:34 a.m. Scott Williams enters.

Bob advised the crack fill machine is here, waiting for dry weather to start the process. He dipped the ditch on Ulery Road. Discussion on the Davenport property on Stafford Road. The Trustees asked if he would be willing to take pictures and be the witness at a hearing if need be and he said yes, however since we have found out that the residents are behind on their taxes, an email was sent to the prosecutor's office and we were advised that a foreclosure process might start within the year. Mr. Davidson is going to contact the auditor's office to see if he can get a more precise date, therefore this issue is being tabled for the time being.

Scott advised he has a new hire starting today, he also advised that in the near future a CO Meter is going to be a mandatory item to be used on squad runs, he is going to seek quotes for one. The EMTs will also start administering shots in place of EPY pens that are very expensive and seem to expire without being used, however there will be training involved as not all EMTs know how to administer shots. He also submitted to Cheryl the Paramedic Good Faith Agreement signed by Bryant Williams.

Jerry advised the hose and ladder test came out OK, nothing was tagged and the annual pump test is coming up. Cheryl advised him she received the Hold Harmless and W9 signed forms back from Mr. Hoblit. He also submitted the signed back page for the updated SOPs.

Mr. Kaffenbarger is still waiting to hear back from Trebel and will fill out the Citizens Complaint form by the next meeting.

Mr. Steele advised there has been clean up activity at the Miller house at 6468 Dialton Road.

Cheryl gave a report on the revenue from the Auction which grossed a total of \$ 60,677.00 minus the fees of \$ 9,812.33 she deposited a check in the amount of 50,864.67, however she needs to increase appropriations for the auction fees.
